**ENFORCEMENT NOTICE**

**MATERIAL CHANGE OF USE**



The Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended)

**ISSUED BY THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SWANSEA ("The Council")  
COUNCIL REFERENCE ENF2019/0279**

1. **THIS NOTICE** is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control under Section 171A(1)(a) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this Notice having regard to the provisions of the development plan and all other material planning considerations. The **annex** at the end of the notice contains important additional information.

2. **THE LAND TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES**

Land at Former Asda Filling Station Trallwn Road Llansamlet Swansea SA7 9UU in the City and County of Swansea ("the Land"), shown edged red on the plan appended hereto ("the Plan").

3. **THE MATTERS WHICH APPEAR TO CONSTITUTE THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL**

Without planning permission, the material change of use from car sales and a car wash to a mixed use of car sales, car wash and car repairs

4. **REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE**

It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last ten years.

1. The use of the land for vehicle repairs is considered unacceptable at this location by virtue of its layout and general appearance and therefore detrimental to the visual amenity of the occupiers of nearby residential properties. The use is therefore contrary to the aims and objectives of Policy PS2 of the Swansea Local Development Plan 2019.

2. The use of the land for vehicle repairs is contrary to Policies RP1, RP2 and RP3 of the Swansea Local Development Plan 2019 by virtue of it causing harm to the local amenity by way of noise, general disturbance, air and noise pollution.

5. **WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO**

1. Cease the use of the land for vehicle repairs and remove all machinery associated with this unauthorised use from the site

6. **TIME FOR COMPLIANCE**


1 month beginning with the day on which this notice takes effect.

**7. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT**

This Notice takes effect on 7<sup>th</sup> October 2019 unless an appeal is made against it before that date.

# ANNEX

## YOUR RIGHT OF APPEAL

## ENFORCEMENT NOTICE APPEAL FEES

Should you choose to appeal this Notice on the grounds that planning permission should be granted for what is alleged in the Notice (Ground a) you are required to pay a fee to the Local Planning Authority. The fee payable in this instance is **£720**. Payments can be made to the City & County of Swansea Council, Planning Control, Civic Centre, Oystermouth Road, Swansea SA1 3SN quoting the reference number as specified on the Enforcement Notice.

## **WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU DO NOT APPEAL**

If you do not appeal against this Enforcement Notice, it will take effect on the date specified in paragraph 7 of the Notice and you must then ensure that the required steps for complying with it, for which you may be held responsible, are taken within the period(s) specified in paragraph 6 of the Notice. Failure to comply with the Enforcement Notice which has taken effect can result in prosecution and/or remedial action by the Council.

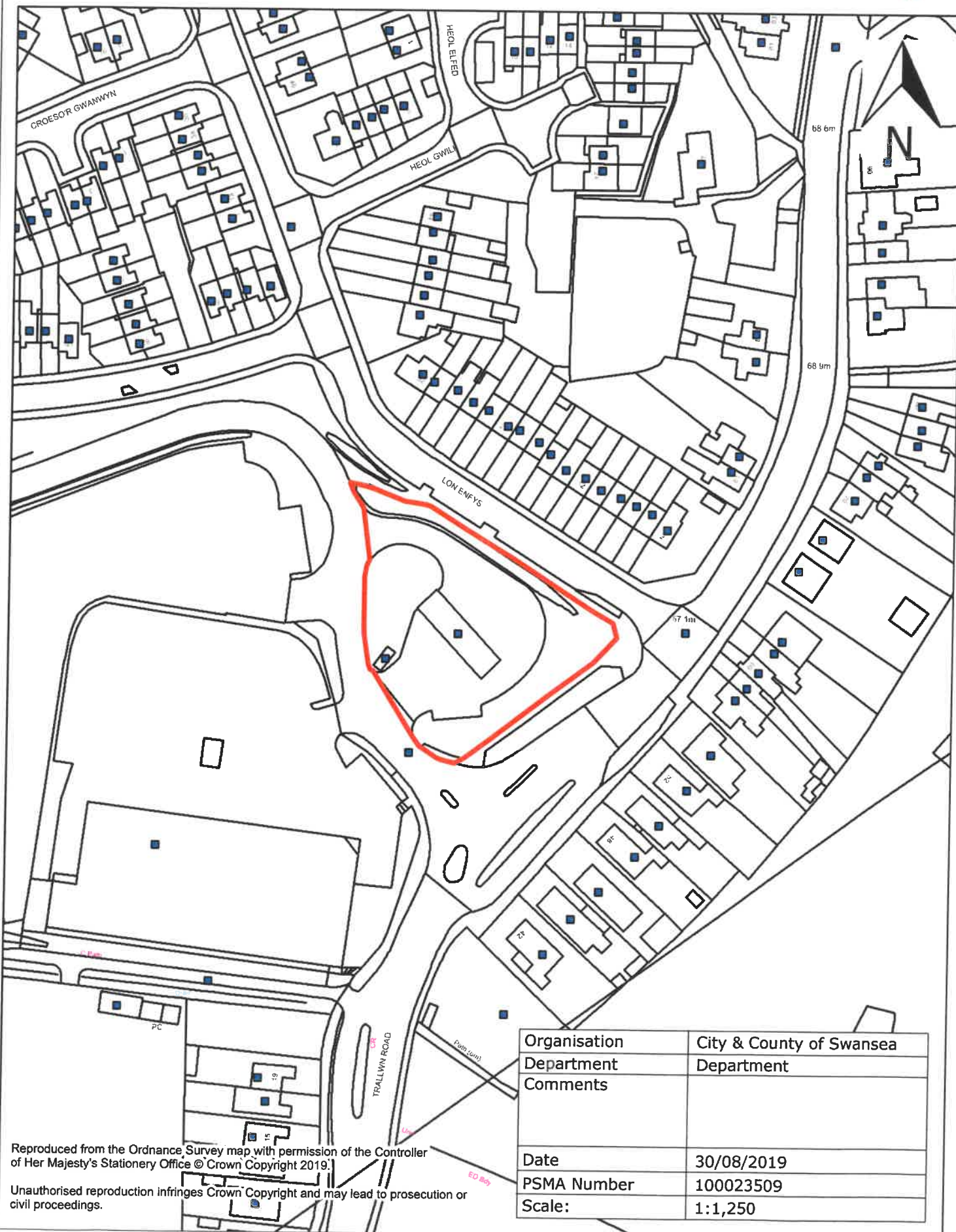
