NOTICE 2024**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the City and County of Swansea in pursuance of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intend to close the above-mentioned road. In order for Openreach to carry out works involving excavating the highway at the above location, it will be necessary to introduce a temporary one way to vehicular traffic for the above road.

SCHEDULE - TEMPORARY ONE-WAY ROAD CLOSURE
B4296 MILL STREET, GOWERTON, SWANSEA

Mill Street from its junction with B4296 Sterry Road in a northerly direction to its junction with the B4295 Gorwydd Road (Gowerton By-pass), a distance of approximately 225 metres.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via the B4295 Gorwydd Road (Gowerton By-pass) and B4296 Sterry Road, a distance of approximately 860 metres.

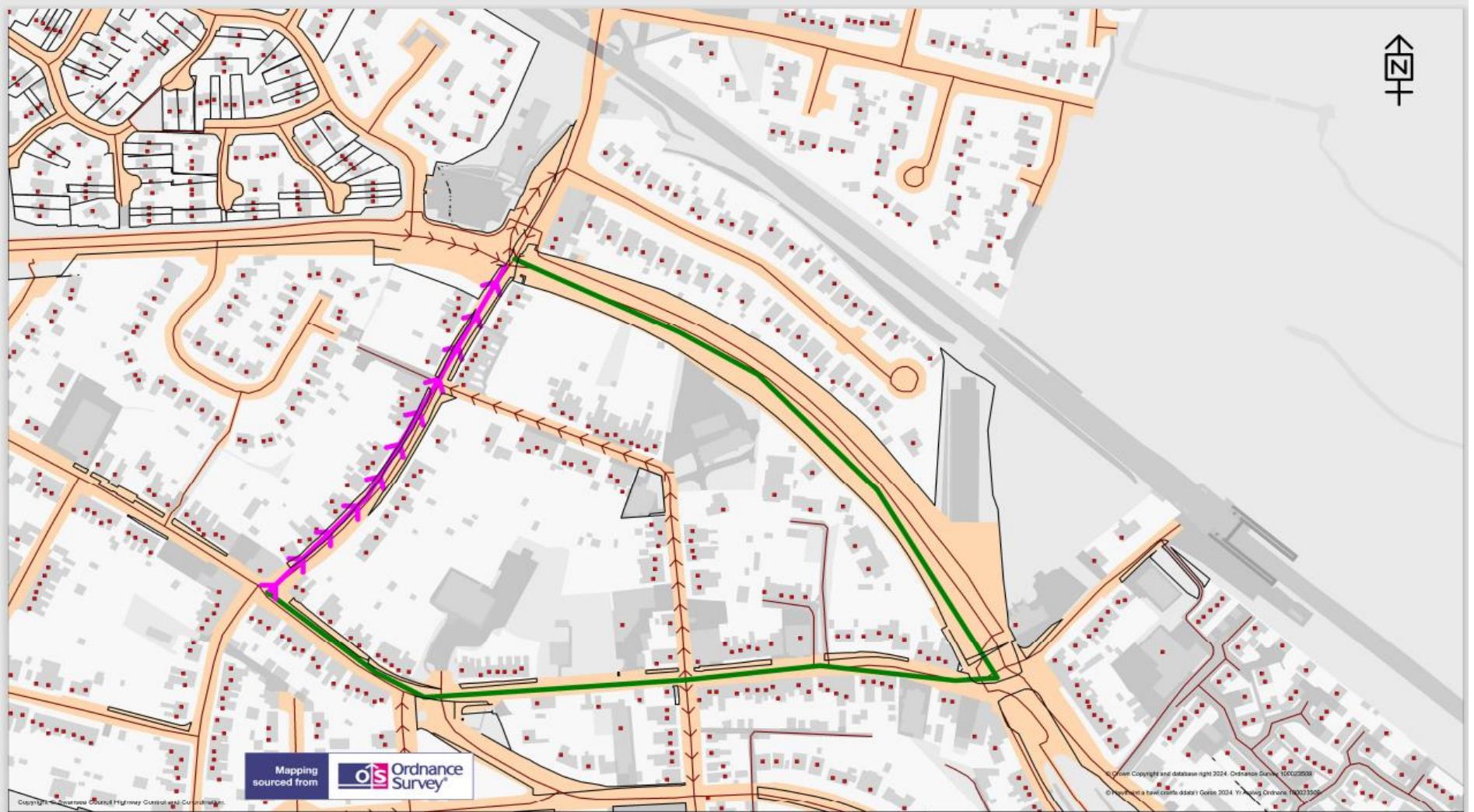
Access for emergency vehicles and pedestrians to be maintained at all times.

The closure will operate from **Sunday 22nd September 2024** for 5 days (Or until the works are completed whichever is the sooner). It is anticipated the works will take 1 day to complete.
