The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Park Place, Alexandra Terrace, and Rhyddings Terrace, a distance of approximately 375 metres.

## Access for emergency vehicles is to be maintained at all times.

The applicant will be responsible for the erection and maintenance of all advanced warning, Road Closed, diversion and alternative route signs in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual and the Traffic Signs and Regulations and General Directions 2016 for the duration of the works.
