NOTICE 2024**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the City and County of Swansea in pursuance of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intend to close the above-mentioned road. In order for Core Highway to facilitate for masonry repairs to a structure at the above location, it will be necessary to temporarily close the above road to vehicular traffic.

SCHEDULE – TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE
CULFOR ROAD (PART), LOUGHOR

Culfor Road in a north-westerly direction from its junction with Pont-Y-Cob Road to its junction with Heol-Y-Wern, a distance of approximately 1 kilometre.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Waun Road, B4620 Glebe Road, A4240 Glebe Road and the unaffected section of Culfor Road, approximately 2.7 kilometres.

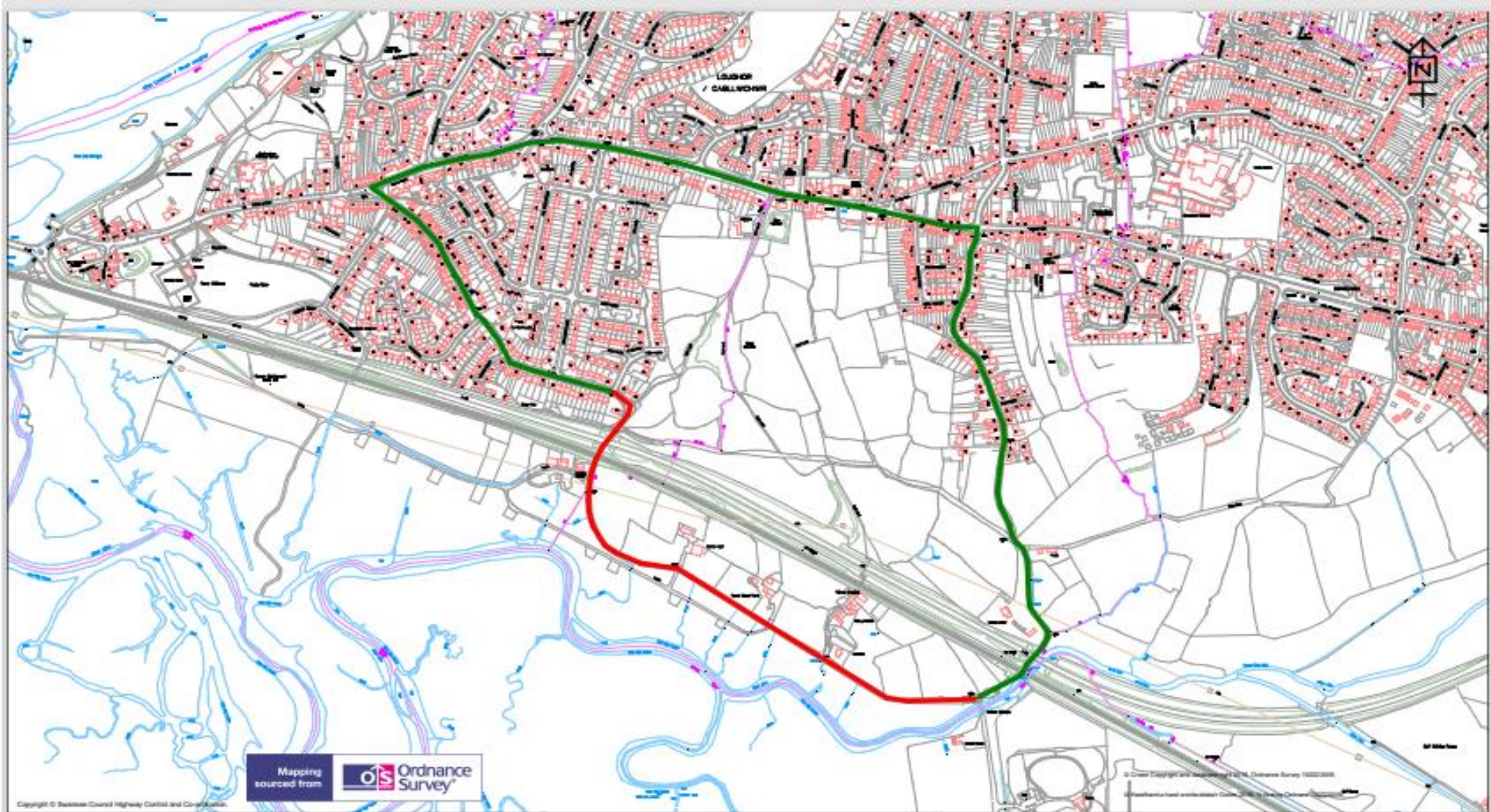
Access for emergency vehicles and pedestrians to be maintained at all times.
