Priors Town in a north-westerly direction from its junction with Atlantic Haven/Walters Lane to its junction with Moors Lane, a distance of approximately 250 metres.

There is no alternative route for vehicular traffic; road plates will be used to allow vehicle access and egress.


## Access for emergency vehicles and pedestrians to be maintained at all times.
