Heathfield in a south-westerly direction from its junction with Mount Pleasant for a distance of approximately 100 metres.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via the unaffected section of Heathfield, Primrose Hill, Cromwell Street, Stanley Street, and Mount Pleasant, a distance of approximately 1 kilometre.

Similarly, this route will operate in the reverse direction.


Access for emergency vehicles and pedestrians to be maintained at all times.
