### **Notes:-**

Occupying a commanding angle site near the brow of the hill. Bryn-Syfi Terrace to side and rear.

Early 20<sup>th</sup> Century. Architect not known. Tudor Gothic style. Red brick with Portland stone dressing. Four storey entrance tower with diagonal buttresses, crenellated parapet with corner pilasters and stripwork surrounding twin bell-openings. Large square-headed four-light mullioned and tansomed windows below drip moulds, small-pane glazing. Doorframe with fine heraldic panel and inscribed lintel over four-centred archway with paterae to deep mouldings, trefoils to spandrels. Flight of steps up flanked by parapets with ironwork lamp standards.

Four storey ranges continue along road with stepped and angled elevation; plain parapets, cross-windows with drip moulds, small-pane glazing. Fine group of brick work chimneys with spiral, chevron and other Tudor mouldings above parapets.

Similar treatment to east flank which also has a three-window arched bridge spanning the road to meet older building (not of special interest).
