In order for Swansea Council to undertake flood alleviation works, it will be necessary to close the above-named road to vehicular traffic.

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE**  
**HEOL Y GORS, TOWNHILL, SWANSEA**

Heol Y Gors in a Westerly direction from its junction with Carmarthen Road to the rear of the BMW garage, approximately 140 metres.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Carmarthen Road, Gors Avenue, and Heol Y Gors, approximately 3.5 Kilometres.

**Access for emergency vehicles to be maintained at all times.**

The maximum duration of the order is 18 months and it is anticipated the work will take 18 months to complete effective from **Thursday 25th September 2025.**

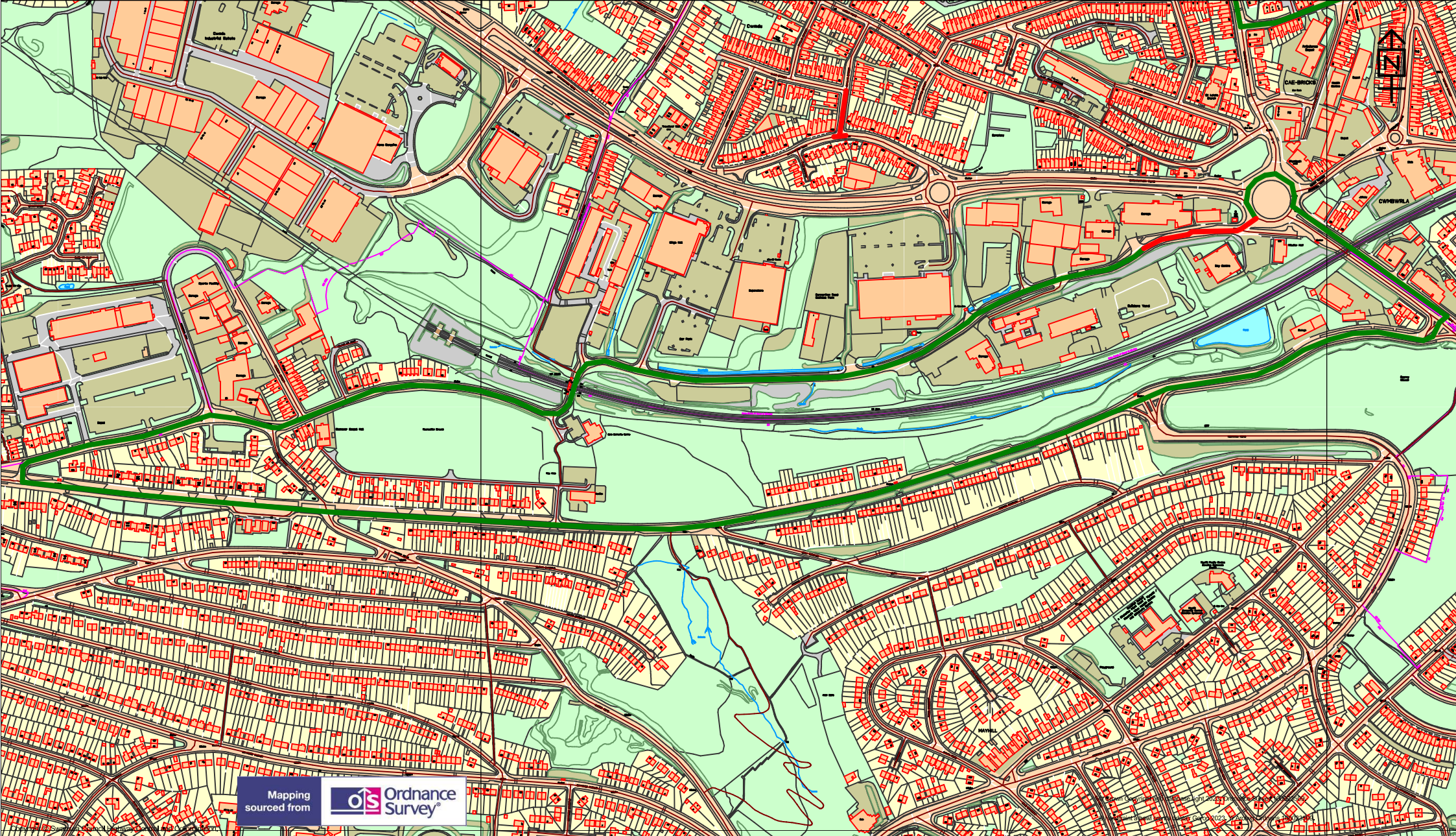
