### **Notes:-**

#### ***Location:-***

Situated on the east side of the farmyard just east of the A483 some 1.7 kilometres south of junction 47 on M4 motorway.

#### ***History:-***

Early to mid 19<sup>th</sup> century outbuilding, one of three around the farm courtyard at Bryn-rhos, a Penllergaer estate farm. All originally were whitewashed and had hipped roofs, replaced with gabled roofs in late 19<sup>th</sup> century probably. This range was cowshed, the dove openings on the south end matching those on the building opposite.

#### ***Exterior:-***

Outbuilding, rubble stone with slate roof, two storeys outside but full height within, seven bays with stone voussiors to all openings. Seven doors below, the fourth altered to a window and the fifth blocked. Seven windows above, but only three opening, in even bays, and these have metal casements. South end wall has blocked unusual dovecote with round opening in centre within a ring of raised stone, and six blocked small openings with shelf below positioned around in hexagon. North end has door to feed passage to left. End gables are added, difference in stonework.

#### ***Interior:-***

Interior has collar truss roof with structure of former hipped ends remaining. Single cowshed in all but last bay, walled off as dovecote each end.

***Listed:-***

Included as part of a little altered 19<sup>th</sup> century estate farm group, a very rare survival in the region.
