Location:-

Situated some half kilometre north east of Felindre, down drive running west from dead-end lane towards Banc Myddfai.

History:-

Late C18 minor gentry house of typical centralised plan with service rooms under outshut rear roof. Much altered in mid to later C19 with concrete tiles for slates and altered windows for small-pane sashes but essentially intact.

Exterior:-

Farmhouse, rendered stone with asbestos-sheet close-eaved roof with rendered end stacks. Two storeys and attic, three-window range with centre small gable over pointed attic window which breaks eaves. Renewed earlier C20 four-pane sashes, gabled centre porch with concrete tiles and pointed entry. C19 four-panel door within, with chamfered and stopped edges to panels. Rendered right end wall, outshut rear with 2 storey lower elevation, two windows above, four windows and centre door below, all mid C20 replacements. Chimney on outshut east end, with tall brick rebuilt shaft.

Interior:-

Included as late C18 formal fronted house with unusual pointed heads to porch entry and attic gable window.
