- 1. These figures are consistent with the Local Authority population estimates for mid-2022 published on 23 November 2023.
- 2. The United Kingdom Statistics Authority has designated these MSOA population statistics as National Statistics.

 The single year data is published by ONS as Supporting Information, but observes the Code of Practice for Official Statistics.
- 3. Whilst the estimates are produced down to unit level, it is not implied that the estimates are accurate to this level of detail. ONS policy is to publish population estimates rounded to at least the nearest hundred persons.
- 4. These estimates reflect the SOA boundaries introduced for the publication of the 2021 Census results. In Swansea, two former MSOAs were merged in 2021 (to create MSOA W02000428 Swansea 032 in the above table).
- 5. At this point, the changed LSOAs and MSOAs have no official area-based names. As an interim measure, unofficial SOA names have been introduced alongside the official ONS codes to help identify areas (these names may be subject to change).
- 6. The 'House of Commons Library MSOA Names' were published in October 2019 and aim to provide recognisable names for MSOAs based on the towns, villages and neighbourhoods that they cover. The names aren't 'official' names for MSOAs, but are intended to provide those using MSOA data with a resource to make that data easier to interpret and present.

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
